Dear Parents

Please find enclosed your copy of your child's final St Benedict's profile. The purpose of this profile is to inform you of the progress that your son/daughter is making as they approach the end of their GCSE studies, in terms of their general level of achievement and effort. Also included are their target grades and levels for the end of this academic year.

Effort Grades in all subjects range from A to E with A being excellent, C satisfactory and E a poor performance. For all GCSE subjects "Working At" and Target Grades range from A\* to G. Some subjects will have different approaches to assessment, for example, for Science, RE and maths(Entry Level) acceptable levels are 3, 2 and 1 and for Aida or Cida the final awards may be Distinction (D), Merit (M), Credit (C), Pass (P) or Fail (F).

Your child will already have been made aware of his/her academic targets in the subjects being studied. Please discuss this report with him/her and the progress being made towards the targets. If your child is following some modular courses, the target and "working at" grades may be similar.

The following exams and consultation will take place in Year 11 on these dates:

Orals and some other practical papers may be held before these dates.

At the consultation evening you will be able to discuss, with individual teachers, the work, progress and where applicable, the level of entry which is being made on behalf of your child. Your son/daughter will have been given a Target Review Sheet to complete, using the information on the profile. You are also invited to bring your child and his/her diary with you to the interviews.

Sarah Gerrard who works with Connexions, the schools' careers service, will also be available for advice during the evening.

If you need to contact the form tutor at any time with regard to the progress of your son/daughter, please do not hesitate to contact the school.
