Dear Parents

Please find enclosed your copy of your child's report. The purpose of this report is to inform you of the progress that your son/daughter is making at the start of their GCSE / SWIFT studies in terms of their general level of achievement and effort. Also included are their target grades and levels for the end of Year 11 in the subjects that they will be following throughout Key Stage 4.

An explanation of the grades and targets awarded can be found at the bottom of the report. All SWIFT/Xtend pupils and other pupils following courses outside the normal curriculum time will receive separate reports from individual colleges in due course. Maths Study Plus and English Study Plus are there to support progress in GCSE and, therefore, only receive an effort grade.

The targets that have been set will be challenging for all pupils, but they should also be achievable. Teaching staff will have considered many aspects of previous performance and experience including KS3 Test Results, Teacher Assessments and other analytical data, in order to arrive at individual targets for each pupil in each subject. Pupils will also be asked to set process targets which will help them to reach their academic targets.

All pupils will already have been made aware of their academic targets in the subjects being studied. Please discuss this report with him/her and the progress being made towards the targets. If your child is following some modular courses, the target and "working at" grades may be similar, and alternatively, if they are following a course not previously studied, eg Spanish, there may appear to be some discrepancy between the target and current working level.

We would expect Effort Grades to be A or B and should your child receive more than two C grades or below in this column we would ask you to discuss this, particularly, with him/her.
